The meeting convened to discuss the two 2025 ARO Award of Merit finalists, Dr. Paul Fuchs and Dr. Larry Trussell. An overview of each candidate, highlighting their contributions and showcasing their significant impact in their fields, was presented to the committee for consideration.

Paul Fuchs was recognized for his pioneering research in hair cell physiology, while Larry Trussell's contributions to neurophysiology were noted for their importance in auditory transmission and mentorship.
